DCPC Youth Ministry Covenant 2021-2022

To care for the DCPC youth community, myself, and my growth in faith, I make the following covenant.

Because I care for myself, I covenant to:

- Trust the DCPC staff and leaders to determine what is appropriate and safe behavior. I will abide by their instructions, particularly the safety and well-being instructions related to the Coronavirus pandemic, like wearing a mask indoors, social distancing, and frequently using hand sanitizer/washing my hands.
- Participate fully, making the most of my time to make friends in Christ and to learn about my relationship with God.
- Always wear a seatbelt and a mask when traveling on a DCPC trip, regardless of the distance or in what vehicle I am riding.
- Not leave the designated area without permission from an adult leader.
- Not have harmful or dangerous items in my possession or use anything which is or could be considered a weapon; any type of explosive device including fireworks or firearms; chemicals of any kind including, but not limited to, tobacco products, alcohol, or any other drug, unless they are listed on my medical form as prescribed medication.
- Not engage in reckless behavior that could result in injury to myself or another participant.

Because I care for my fellow youth and leaders, I covenant to:

- Leave my cool at the door. I will treat others as children of God, created in God's own image. I will strive to act as an individual created in God's image—reaching out to all participants without regard to stereotypes placed upon us by the world.
- Choose words that build up others. I will not use abusive language, words which are intended to hurt, inappropriate jokes, sexual comments, or any language which cuts down a particular race, gender, social standing, physical or mental handicap, or sexual orientation.
- Abide by these COVID-19 precautions: wear a mask indoors, social distancing, and hand sanitizing/washing.
- Stay home if I've been exposed to someone with COVID-19 (exposure means 15 minutes of contact at less than 6 feet of distance while unmasked) or if I have the following symptoms and that do not have another known cause: fever, chills, cough, shortness of breath or difficulty breathing, fatigue, muscle or body aches, headache, new loss of taste or smell, sore throat, congestion or runny nose, nausea or vomiting, diarrhea.
- Use technology responsibly in a way that does not isolate me from others. Phones, tablets, etc., limit our ability to interact with another and can make us unapproachable. We ask that all youth abide by directions on electronics given by any adult leader. Failure to respect requests to turn off phones, stop texting, or otherwise play with electronics could result in temporary confiscation.

Because I care for all God's people and creation, I covenant to:

- Respect the places where we meet, serve, worship, and play by not damaging any property and repairing any property I damage (on purpose or inadvertently).
- Act in a way which brings glory to God and represents Davidson College Presbyterian Church in a way reflective of the Gospel.
